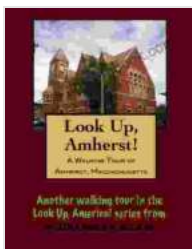


A Walking Tour of Amherst, Massachusetts: A Look Up America Series

The tour ends at the Robert Frost Farm.

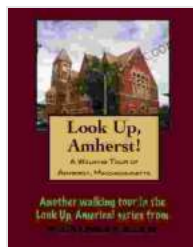
The "Look Up America" walking tour is a great way to experience Amherst's history and culture. The tour takes you past some of the town's most

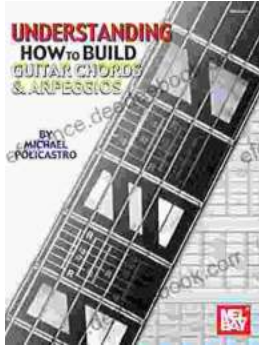
