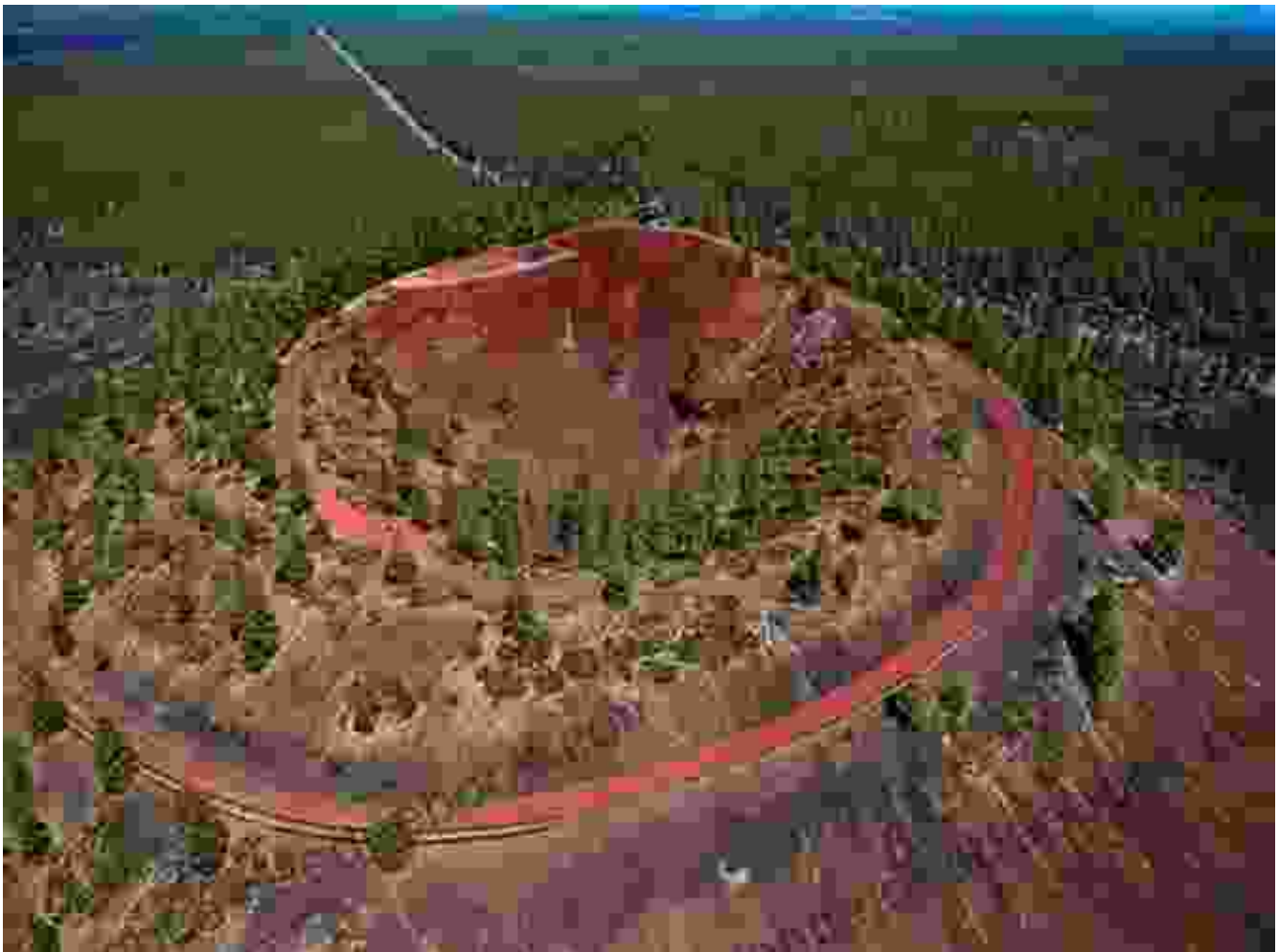


Tumalo Falls, a hidden gem in the High Desert with a thunderous waterfall and scenic hiking trails
