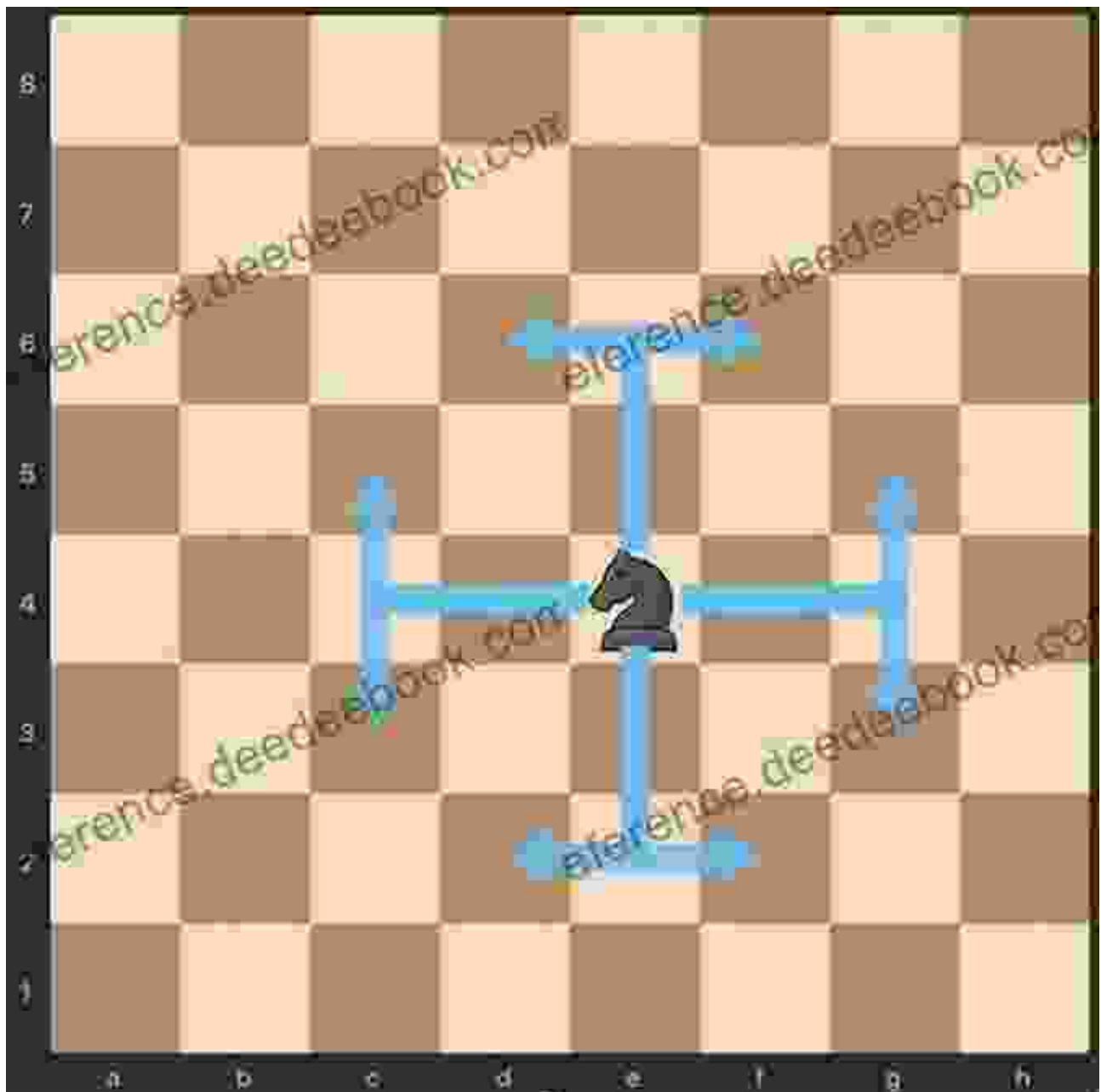
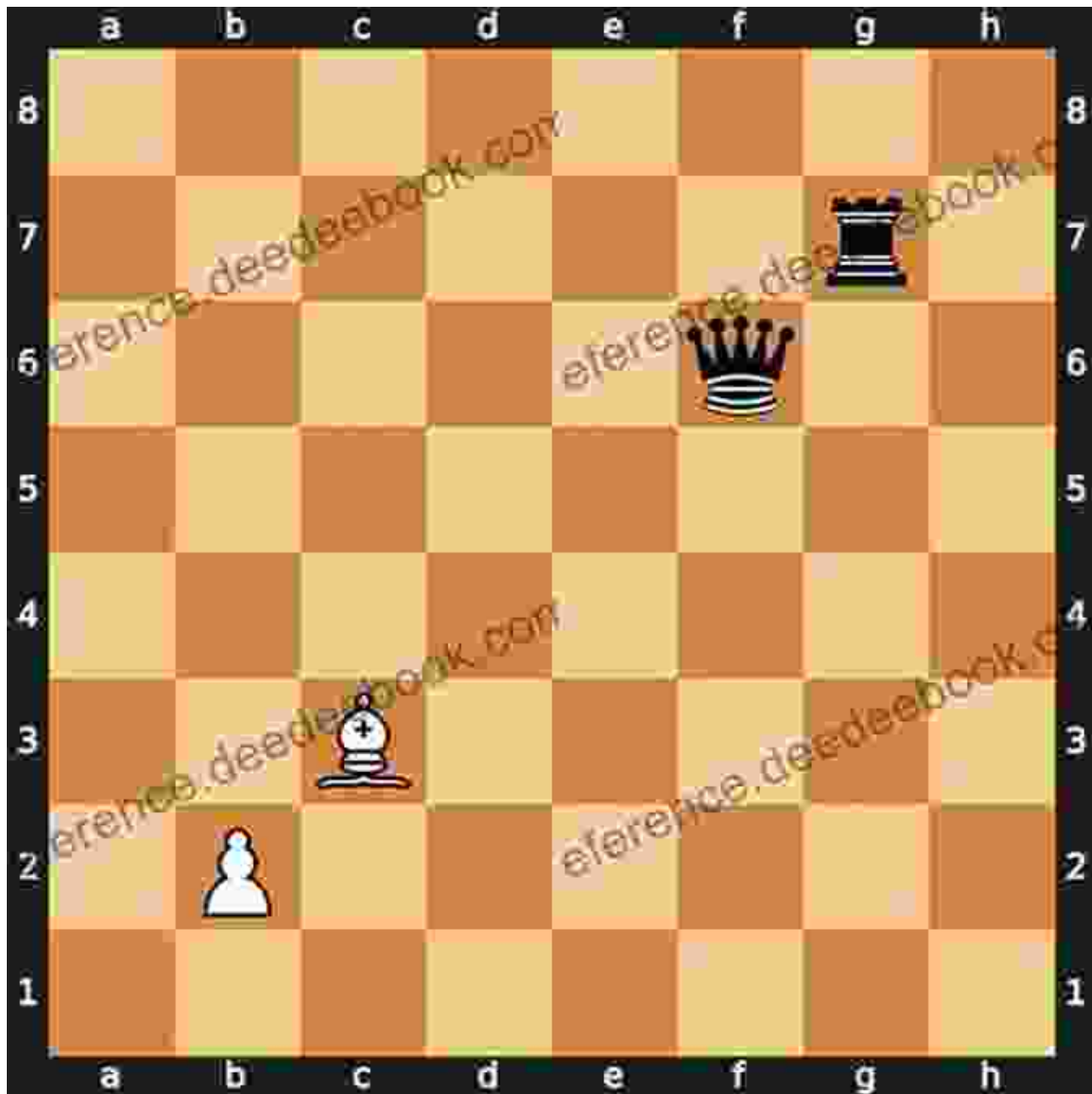


Figure 2: A Paralyzing Bishop Pin

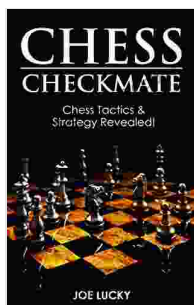

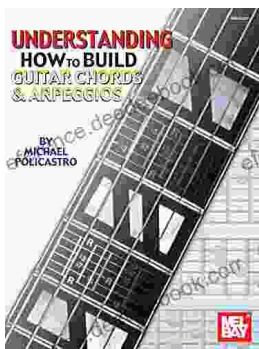

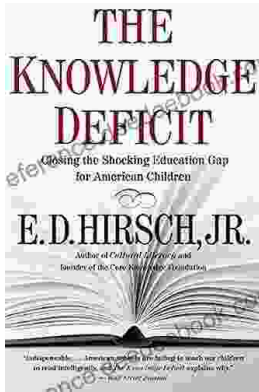
