Materials You'll Need

- Worsted weight yarn in two colors (main color and accent color)
- Size US 7 (4.5mm) knitting needles

- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Measuring tape
- Stitch markers (optional)

Step-by-Step Instructions

Newborn Baby Hat (0-3 months)

1. **Cast on:** 72 stitches with main color.
2. **Ribbing:** Knit 1, purl 1 for 10 rows.
3. **Body:** Knit all stitches in main color until the hat measures approximately 5 inches from the cast-on edge.
4. **Decrease:** Knit two stitches together every 12th stitch for 6 rounds.
5. **Crown:** Knit all stitches in main color until the hat measures approximately 6.5 inches from the cast-on edge.
6. **Bind off:** Knit two stitches together until only 6 stitches remain. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail, and pull it through the remaining stitches to close the hat.

Toddler Hat (1-3 years)

1. **Cast on:** 84 stitches with main color.
2. **Ribbing:** Knit 1, purl 1 for 12 rows.
3. **Body:** Knit all stitches in main color until the hat measures approximately 6 inches from the cast-on edge.

4. **Decrease:** Knit two stitches together every 14th stitch for 6 rounds.
5. **Crown:** Knit all stitches in main color until the hat measures approximately 7.5 inches from the cast-on edge.
6. **Bind off:** Knit two stitches together until only 6 stitches remain. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail, and pull it through the remaining stitches to close the hat.

Child Hat (4-8 years)

1. **Cast on:** 96 stitches with main color.
2. **Ribbing:** Knit 1, purl 1 for 14 rows.
3. **Body:** Knit all stitches in main color until the hat measures approximately 7 inches from the cast-on edge.
4. **Decrease:** Knit two stitches together every 16th stitch for 6 rounds.
5. **Crown:** Knit all stitches in main color until the hat measures approximately 8.5 inches from the cast-on edge.
6. **Bind off:** Knit two stitches together until only 6 stitches remain. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail, and pull it through the remaining stitches to close the hat.

Adding the Truck Hauler Details

Wheels

- Change to accent color.
- Cast on 8 stitches.

- Knit all stitches for 4 rows.
- Bind off all stitches.
- Make four wheels.

Truck Body

- Change to main color.
- Cast on 24 stitches.
- Knit all stitches for 10 rows.
- Bind off all stitches.

Assembly

1. Sew the wheels to the truck body.
2. Sew the truck body to the front of the hat.
3. Embroider or sew on any additional details, such as headlights, a grill, or a number.

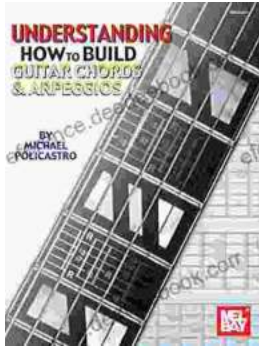

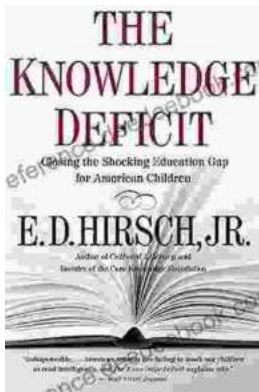
