

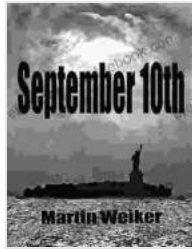
September 10th: Jakub Grygiel's Unforgettable Journey from Poland to American Football Stardom

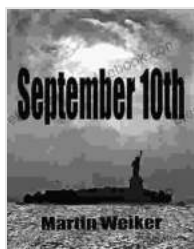

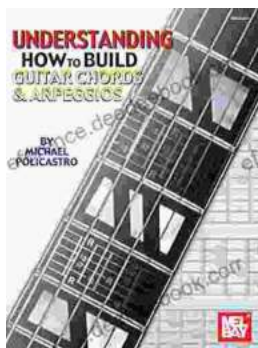
