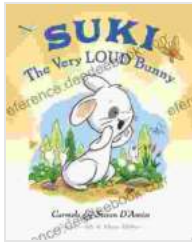

Suki had always loved making noise, but she learned that sometimes, the most important things are the ones that are left unsaid.

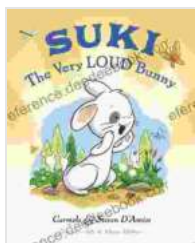
A Quiet Discovery

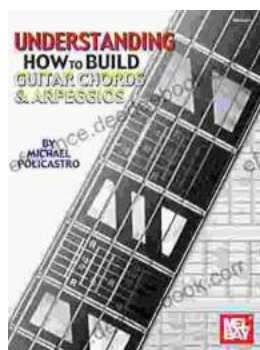

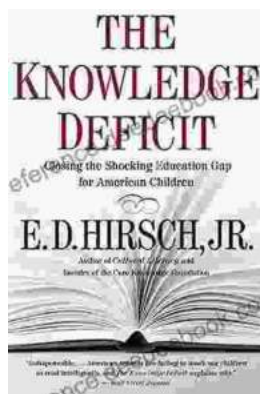
